

## **Buying at Moreton Pinkney Auction with Covid-19 Restrictions**

Following this guidance and legislation allows us to hold an auction with more than 30 people in attendance. We ask that you familiarise yourself with this information before visiting the venue.

We thank you all for your support and cooperation during these uncertain times.

### **Parking**

- FRIDAY – Park anywhere in the car park as usual.
- SATURDAY – Parking is ONLY on the field. NO EXCEPTIONS.

### **Registration**

- Current legislation means we require a name, address and contact number for each household to comply with the government's Track & Trace scheme.
- If you are already registered as a bidder and your details are up to date, we do not require any other information.
- Anyone wishing to view the auction will have to provide their details – even if they do not stay to bid.

### **PPE & Social Distancing**

- Appropriate face masks/coverings are required BY LAW to enter the hall for viewing.
- Disposable gloves are advised, but not compulsory.
- Hand sanitizer will be available on entry, exit and at various points throughout.
- Face coverings are not required whilst outside of the hall, but are strongly advised.
- Social distancing within the hall will be based on the government's 1m+ system. If capacity is reached, we will implement a "one out, one in" policy, with a socially distanced queue.
- We have a strict one way system in place. No exceptions.

### **Refreshments**

- There will be NO refreshments available but we encourage you to bring your own - especially drinks.
- Please take all rubbish/wrappers home with you.

### **Toilets**

- Only one person at a time may enter the toilets due to social distancing – with the exception of parents with young children.
- During viewing the toilets will be subject to the same one way system as viewing, to avoid people crossing paths face to face. No exceptions.
- During the auction, toilets can only be accessed via the main doors. There will be no admittance to the main hall.
- Please spray the seat/urinal with the antibacterial cleanser provided when you have finished.
- Hand sanitizer will be available.

## Viewing

- 2:30-6:30pm on the Friday before the auction.
- 8am-10am on the day of the auction.
- Commission bid forms will be available on entry. Please drop completed forms into the designated suitcase on exit. Alternatively, bids can be emailed to us at [info@antiques2go.co.uk](mailto:info@antiques2go.co.uk).
- Avoid touching items where possible.
- Viewing items in the cabinet is subject to a different entrance and one way system. Please advise on entry if you wish to view the cabinet lots, your number will be called when there is space to view.

## Auction

- Commission bids are encouraged, to limit the number of people on site.
- Any lot too large to fit in a standard supermarket fruit/veg box will need to be collected by 4:30pm on the day of the auction, or have a delivery arrangement in place (speak to the office for details and prices).
- The auction will be live on Saturday morning, in the car park.
- Some shade/shelter will be provided but please dress appropriately for the Great British weather!
- Seating will be very limited due to social distancing. **YOU ARE WELCOME TO BRING YOUR OWN CAMPING CHAIRS** as long as social distancing is observed.

## Payment & Collection

- Only two customers at a time in the office. One at the invoice desk, one at the payment desk. Please queue outside until someone leaves.
- We ARE accepting cash – as well as debit and credit cards.
- Exit via the small passageway and drop your invoice into the waiting tray. Your items will be picked to one of the tables outside.
- If you have larger items to collect, you are welcome to move your car to the designated **LOADING BAY**. Please only use these spaces if you have large or heavy items to collect.
